

TERRA PINOT GRIS 2010 BIOBIO

BIO BIO VALLEY

This valley is situated 500 km south of Santiago and 50 km far from the coast. It is characterized for having a temperate Mediterranean climate with a significant influence from the sea. There are around 1200 mm of rain per year. The characteristics of the valley permit the grapes to ripen slowly, preserving their freshness and the intensity of their flavors and aromas.

OUR VINES

Bio Bio Valley
Santa Carla Estate
Clay loam soil, poor fertility
Slight north-facing slope
Temperate Mediterranean climate with coastal influence

HARVEST

First week of March 2009
10.0 ton/hectare

VINIFICATION

Gentle pressing after grapes are destemmed
Cold maceration with fine lees for 1 week
Racking and fermentation at a low temperature
for 4 weeks in stainless steel tanks

AGEING

100% of the wine is kept in contact with
fine lees for 5 months to build
structure and a buttery quality

BOTTLED

Coarse Earth filtration before bottling

TastingNotes

This refreshing and bright white has a sappy edge to its pear and citrus flavours, with almond blossom and orange peel aromas and flavours that linger nicely on a mouthwatering and mineral finish
