Mendoza sits high in the foothills of El Plata Mountain, named by the Spanish for silver. In line with Argentó's philosophy, we hand pick vineyards from the best regions around Mendoza, each with its own personality, allowing us to create fresh, intense wines of fruit purity and finesse.

Tasting Note	This fruity and refreshing Chardonnay offers enticing aromas of tropical pineapple and lime citrus. Concentrated flavours of honeydew melon and passion fruit are complemented by subtle minerality leading into a fresh, crisp finish.
